These guidelines are to clarinhen funding, bothinternal and external, are to belassified and reported as esearch activity or nonresearch activity.

Funding is to be classified as 'research' when it is intended to conduct or support research activities. Segregation will be made between external and internal activity. There will be instances where fundinged for research and educational activities in these scenarios the classification will be based on which activity has a higher percentage split (greater than 50%). When the total award is greater than \$100,000, and there is a mix of research and educational activities, consideration will be given to separate the funding into multiple projects.
