Canada Research Chair (CRC) Tier II

Tier 2 Chairs are intended for exceptional emerging scholars (i.e., candidates must have been an active researcher in their field for fewer than 10 years at the time of nomination). Candidates who are more than 10 years from having earned their highest degree and who have had breaks, such as maternity, parental, or extended sick leave, clinical training, etc., may have their eligibility for a Tier II
