Outstanding Achievement Awards are available to students entering their first year of post-secondary studies, who will be admitted to the University on the basis of their high school grades. Students must be entering a Fall Session at the University of Calgary. In order to be considered for Entrance Awards, students must **also** complete an application form for Entrance Awards. Students entering the Bachelor of Health Sciences program in the Faculty of Medicine, are eligible to apply for the Bachelor of Health Sciences Achievement Awards. Upon completion of the first year of post-secondary studies at the University of Calgary, a student is then eligible to apply for Undergraduate Awards.

The following points should be considered when applying for an Outstanding Achievement Award:

- Complete only one Outstanding Achievement Award application form to be considered for awards in this category. Application must be made on the current application form.
- Students must normally have earned a minimum average of 88.0% throughout high school to apply for Outstanding Achievement Awards.
- Outstanding Achievement Awards application forms are available from the Student Awards and Financial Aid office or Alberta high school counsellors. Application forms may also be printed off the Student Awards and Financial Aid office web site upon availability: www.ucalgary.ca/awards/
- Application for awards must be made on the current application form.
- Completed application forms for Outstanding Achievement Awards must be post-marked or received by the Student Awards and Financial Aid office on or before **December 1 of the year prior to entering the University.**
- Request the appropriate issuing agency/institution(s) to send one official high school transcript directly to the Registrar's Office as standard admission procedures require.
- Students need not have applied for admission to the University prior to applying for these awards.
- Unless otherwise stated in the terms of reference, the recipients must be in actual full-time attendance at the University of Calgary before *receiving* the awards.
- In order that awards may be equitably distributed, no student may normally hold more than one major award administered by the University of Calgary in any given year.
