All activities take place on University property unless otherwise noted

- a) Anatomy Labs– Faculty of Medicine instructional/educational programs.

- f) Minds in Motion - Instructional programs which use University facilities

 - Backpacking – Kananaskis Country or wilderness areas where the University has a permit to teach these activities;
 - Bike Repair Clinics
 - Canoeing - takes place at:
 - The University's pool and/or a community pool (if it takes place at the University's pool it may also include facility rental);
 - City of Calgary locations such as
 - o Glenmore reservoir;
 - o Bowness Lagoon and/or City lakes and areas where the University has a Permit to teach these activities

- o The Bow River; and
 - Kananaskis River and lakes and wilderness areas where the University has a permit to teach these activities
 - Climbing and Bouldering
 - Cross Country Skiing—takes place at:
 - City of Calgary locations where the University is contracted/permitted to teach these activities and
 - Kananaskis Country or wilderness areas where the University has a permit to teach these activities
 - Glacier Hiking/Mountaineering Skills—Equipment rental and/or instructional programs which take
