This diversifying economy means a shift in labour market demand across sectors and between occupations within sectors. Alberta has moved away from goods production over the past twenty years, to an information and knowledge-based economy. While most jobs categories have seen an increase in job creation since the turn of the century, 85% of total new jobs arose in the service sector, and the proportion of all jobs in the service sector rose from 74% to 77%. As Figure 2 shows, two of the top three fastest growing occupations are primarily served by the university sector.
